mastering advanced modern chinese through the classics is a textbook to teach those who wish to achieve an advanced or native proficiency and cultural competence in modern chinese as well as to experience the beauty of classical chinese literature collecting representative works containing vibrant views of chinese culture from different dynasties this book is focused on how the grammatical patterns vocabulary and idioms that are found in classical chinese are relevant in the modern adaptation of the language and how the accumulated traditional values and beliefs found there still shape the thinking and lifestyle of modern society online resources including audio answer keys and instructor aids will be part of the teaching package

this book shows that classic chinese philosophy is as rational as western approaches dealing with the problems of logic epistemology language analysis and linguistic topics from a philosophical point of view it presents detailed analyses of rational and methodological features in confucianism taoist philosophy and the school of names as well as mohist approaches in classical chinese philosophy especially in regard to ideas of valid knowledge the authors also provide new arguments against cultural relativism and antirational movements like religious fundamentalism that do not pay due attention to what all human beings have in common to cultural universals

a classical chinese reader is the result of many years of teaching at the university of sydney when i first started teaching there was little to help the undergraduate student embarking on the study of classical chinese in response to student pleas i started to provide vocabularies and grammatical notes and finally decided to publish my notes from the preface

this volume introduces readers to classical chinese literature from its beginnings ca 10th century bce to the tenth century bce through a conceptual framework centered on textual production and transmission it focuses on recuperating historical perspectives for the period it surveys and attempts to draw connections between the past and present

yue s book explores the nature of translation using traditional chinese medicine tcm and the tcm classic huangdi neiijing and its various translations yue examines in great detail and depth the important factors that cause the differences in the translators treatment of language indeterminacies apart from having multi faceted and fine grained linguistic analysis this book also serves as a good model of methodology in terms of corpus building contrastive analysis exemplification and glossing following systemic functional linguistics sfl convention this book is an argument for greater emphasis on the linguistic notion of register in translator s expertise specifically in the way that professional experience and training with their registerial demands may be the key to semantic decisions forced on a translator by the inevitable vagaries and indeterminacies of establishing a working equivalence across languages and cultures and deep time it probes the issue in an extreme case the debate over who is the ideal translator in chinese medicine translation through various case studies the result suggests it is possible to demonstrate empirically that clinical experience in translators is likely to have consistent or even measurable consequences this book will be of interest to three different fields translators in training applicable systemic functional linguistics and traditional chinese medicine communication

this textbook for beginning students contains 35 lessons of increasing difficulty designed to introduce students to the basic patterns of classical chinese and to provide practice in reading a variety of texts the lessons are structured to encourage students to do more work with dictionaries and other references as they progress through the book the introduction provides an overview of the grammar of literary chinese part i presents eight lessons on sentence structure parts of speech verbs and negatives part ii consists of sixteen intermediate level lessons and part iii offers five advanced level selections part iv has six

lessons based on tang and song dynasty prose and poetry

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this new edition offers expanded selections from the works of kongzi confucius mengzi mencius zhuangzi chuang tzu and xunzi hsun tzu two new works the dialogues robber zhi and white horse a concise general introduction brief introductions to and selective bibliographies for each work and four appendices that shed light on important figures periods texts and terms in chinese thought

this book systematically depicts the theory of textual patterns chengshi of the eight part essays and logic in ancient chinese texts with the rare materials it covers all the basic and important aspects of the whole process and values of chengshi such as the transformation of different parts and the coherent expression of the doctrines the planning of writing and the application to the aesthetic and pedagogic fields it also explores the similarities and disparities of logical patterns between ancient chinese and western texts though entirely fresh and tentative the contrastive studies get new insights into the logic and philosophical concepts hidden in the writings for better understanding of the uniqueness and richness implied in chinese culture
